- There is limited RV camping available at the Elks Lodge. Contact Frank Staley (fathergoosef.g@gmail.com or (623) 826-1092) for all RV camping inquires, please do not call the Elks Lodge. Information on other camping, RV and hotel options will be available at www.arizonatrailriders.org.
- There is a 225 rider limit for this event. Registration is open to street legal Dual sport or adventure motorcyclists only.
- Participants MUST show proof of AMA membership at Check-In. If you are not an AMA member there is a 2-Day AMA membership available for \$20.
- Registration is open through October 14, 2018. After October 14th Walks up may be available but will not include meals or t-shirt. If extra meals are available they may be purchased at the event
- 2-Day Pre Registration for Dual Sport DAY RIDE is \$110.00 per rider
- 2-Day Pre Registration for the Adventure OVERNIGHT ride is \$80.00 per rider
- 1-Day options are available for the Dual Sport DAY RIDE event only for \$85.00 per rider
- All participants who Pre Register prior to Oct 1st, 2018 will receive a special 10th Anniversary "Howlin' at the Moon" T-shirt.
- For both events passengers ride for free but must purchase additional meal tickets
- All riders must be registered for event. No non-registered riders will be allowed to ride with other participants
- The Friday Night Fish Fry at the Elks Lodge is not included in entry fee

Dual Sport DAY RIDE info:

- The 2-Day entry fee includes Saturday Breakfast, Saturday Lunch, Saturday Dinner, and Sunday breakfast. For 1-day options see ticket description.
- There are A, B, and C routes available both days. 'A' routes are the toughest and include technical 2-track and single track trail. 'B' routes are a mix of maintained and un-maintained roads and should be considered "Hero" routes for Adventure riders. The 'C' routes are big bike friendly and will be paved roads along with maintained and semi-maintained dirt roads.
- Saturday starts with breakfast at the Elks Lodge. All routes will go to Crown King, AZ for lunch and gas then loop back to Prescott Valley. After the ride everyone is invited to the Elks Lodge for the Banquet and raffle.
- Sunday starts with another great breakfast at the Elks Lodge. All Sunday routes are loops through the forest around Prescott.
- Roll Charts are available by request when you register. GPS track-logs will be emailed to all registered participants prior to the event.

Adventure OVERNIGHT ride info:

- The entry fee includes Saturday breakfast in Prescott Valley along with Sunday breakfast at the Antlers Cafe in Young, Az. Saturday and Sunday lunch and Saturday Night Dinner is on you.
- Saturday the ride starts at the Prescott Valley Elks Lodge. You will travel some of the most scenic and fun routes in Arizona to Young, Az where you will spend the night.
- Sunday starts with breakfast at The Antlers then it's a completely different route back to Prescott Valley
- The ride is GPS only, no roll chart is available, and the tracks will be emailed to all registered participants prior to the event.
- Dry tent camping is available at the Antler's. Firewood and bathrooms are available.
- There is limited lodging available in Young for Saturday night so we recommend you make your reservations as soon as possible. We recommend the Pleasant Valley Inn 928-462-3593 or Dead Broke Inn 928-462-4022.
